

Anna Gupta is Professor of Social Work in the Department of Social Work, Royal Holloway University of London. She is a registered social worker and before joining academia in 2000, worked as a social worker and team manager in two London boroughs, and as a Children's Guardian in the family courts. Her research interests include child protection/ welfare policy and practice with families living in poverty, Black and minority ethnic children and families, children in care and adoption. Her recent work has included participatory approaches and co-production with families living in poverty who have experienced social work services, and she is working with London local authorities to develop parent/peer advocacy and other family inclusion practices. Two of her recent publications are a co-written book: *'Protecting Children: A Social Model'*, and a co-edited book: *'Unaccompanied Young Migrants: Identity, care and Justice'*.
